IN-CLASSROOM OPPORTUNITIES

Art for Bears (AFB) Coordinator: Coordinators create & maintain volunteer schedule for all Art for Bears sessions (every other week) throughout the school year. AFB Coordinators generally attend each Art for Bears class as a parent volunteer. *Contact Lead Room Parent (LRP) or Classroom Teacher.*

Art for Bears (AFB) Volunteer: Volunteers assist Mrs. Libby with various tasks in the art room, such as distributing and cleaning materials, assisting students with their art projects, and mounting finished art work. *Contact Lead Room Parent (LRP) or Classroom Teacher.*

Library: Library volunteers check books in and out and help shelve books, during their child's weekly library class. A training session is required at the beginning of the school year.

Class Parties: Volunteers will be needed to bring in party supplies such as food, drinks, plates, and other materials as requested. Volunteers will also be needed to set up and clean up for the party.
